You may not know this, but our Society recently started to monitor the beaches in the area for "Forage Fish" spawning. During our December beach assessment, we found evidence of Sand Lance spawning (post spawn carcasses) on the beach within 100 meters of the dock. So, the dock removal is very timely indeed.
